**N.B:** The current wage increases have been determined by utilizing the CPI (excluding owners' equivalent rent) reported by Stats SA on 19 April 2017. The current level of CPI is **6.4%**. The wage increase is therefore determined by adding **6.4%** plus **1.5%** as stated in the current Sectoral Determination. The total increase is **7.9%**
